LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS

A ball lying, in, on, or over a boundary hedge, fence or over a ditch is out of bounds. The white stakes mark the out of bounds on the 11th, 12th, 13th, 16th, 17th, 18th and the areas in front of the clubhouse.

2. GROUND UNDER REPAIR

Areas of GUR are defined by blue lines or GUR signs. Play is prohibited from these areas and also if such an area interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 25-1.

3. ALL PROTECTED TREES ARE MARKED

With white stakes, plastic sheaths or wire mesh. The ball should be dropped one club length from the nearest point which avoids damage to the protected tree from the stroke at the ball.

4. THE FOLLOWING ARE DEEMED TO BE

Immovable obstructions:-
Artificial paths/display boards/shelters/steps on tees/fixed sprinkler heads. Take relief under Rule

24-2. The ball shall be played as it lies in respect of wooden bridges, soil and sand paths which are an integral part of the course.

5. ALL LATERAL WATER HAZARDS

Are marked with red stakes or lines.
(Rule 26 applies).

6. STONES IN BUNKERS ARE

Movable obstructions. Take relief under Rule 24-1.

7. GAMES IN PROGRESS

Will have preference on the tee, but games starting should alternate.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE

Match Play - Loss of hole;

Stroke Play - Two strokes.

In the event that a ball is lost in GUR, this is covered by Rule 25-1c.
